Job Objective: Oversee operations of the dining room food services.

Essential Functions:

This job description should not be interpreted as all inclusive. It is intended to identify the essential functions and requirements of the position. Other job-related responsibilities and tasks may be assigned. Reasonable accommodation may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential job functions.

- Must have or obtain Independence, MO, Health Department Food Service Certificate.
- Oversee and monitor the dining room staff.
- Assign duties to the dining room staff.
- Make sure dining room is prepped and ready for meals.
- Greet guests/campers as they go through the serving line.
- Grant permission for campers to come into the dining hall.
- Ensure campers are lined up in an orderly fashion.
- Inform campers of dining hall rules and enforce rules.
- Help clean tables, counters, etc. in the dining room.
- Before meals, help put out condiments, cereal, and other items. Following meals, help put away condiments, cereal, and other items.
- Assist in the cleaning and setup of dining room areas.
- Oversee sweeping and mopping of dining room and hallway.
- Assist in beverage preparation.

- Assist in tearing down and setting up of dining room weekly for thorough cleaning.
- Assist in serving of camper snacks.
- Help collect and submit Summer Food Service Program paperwork.
- Be a positive influence on campers, leading by example.
- Be aware of and follow all Three Trails Camp policies and procedures.
- Attend all staff and camp meetings.
- Carry out assignments given for camp registration.
- Other duties as assigned

Minimum Qualifications:

Education: NA

Experience: Experience in food services preferred.

Certifications/Licenses: Must have or obtain Independence MO, Health Department Food Service Certificate or certification from approved city or program.

Skills/Abilities: Ability to work long hours with limited breaks.

Supervisory Responsibility: Oversee dining room aides, volunteers and campers in the dining hall area.

Safe from Harm Level: 3 Camp Training

Blood borne Pathogen Level: 3

Physical Requirements:

Speaking, hearing and vision ability, and excellent manual dexterity to be able to perform oversee operation of dining room.

Lifting, pulling, and pushing of materials up to 25 pounds to setup/tear down dining room.

Requires bending, squatting and walking.

Standing up to 6-8 hours per day.

Travel: Not required

Driving: Driving not required, but preferred. Staff with a valid license from the state of residence will apply for approval through The Salvation Army Fleet Safety Program. If approved, the candidate might be asked to drive either a Salvation Army or personal vehicle on Salvation Army business.

Working Conditions: Work is performed in the camp dining hall and does include weekdays and weekends based on the summer camp and divisional schedule.

All employees recognize that The Salvation Army is a church and agree that they will do nothing as an employee of The Salvation Army to undermine its religious mission.
